

**Grassroots Arts Program - Base County Allotments for Fiscal Year 2025-26  
Estimated Allocation Chart - January 14, 2025**

These figures are based on the Grassroots allocations of \$3,803,708 million for all counties and an additional \$2,500,000 for Tier 1 and Tier 2 counties, and Tier 3 counties with populations of less than 250,000 people (assigned by formula with 20 percent in equal grants to all eligible counties and 80 percent by population base). The state population of 11,107,246 is determined by the 2025 population projection prepared by the State Data Center. The multicultural columns show the amount of the allotments that each county must spend on programming that reflects African American, Asian American, Latino, or Native American cultures. Percentages and allotments are rounded to the nearest whole unit.
